

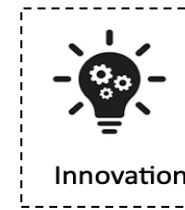

Key Vocabulary for this Unit

fire		Fire is when something burns, creating heat, flames and often smoke.
diary		A diary is a book that somebody writes in, often writing about their life or their feelings.
materials		A material is what something is made of.
bakery		A bakery is a place that makes food, such as bread and cakes.
rebuild		The process of building something again after it has been damaged.
