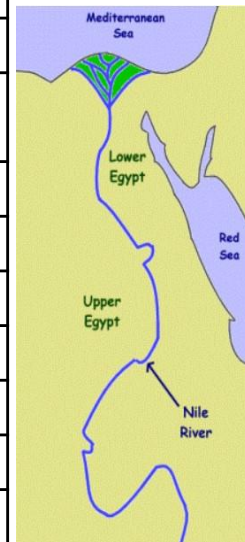


KEY VOCABULARY

Afterlife	The place where Egyptians believed they would go after they died.
Canopic jars	Special jars that held the internal organs of a mummy.
Dynasty	A period of rule when the pharaohs all came from the same family.
Hieroglyphics	Writing that used a combination of pictures and symbols.
Mummification	The process of preserving a body after death.
Papyrus	A plant that was used as an early version of paper.
Pharaoh	The supreme ruler of Ancient Egypt.
Pyramids	A four-sided tomb for a pharaoh.
Rosetta Stone	A stone with writing that helped decode hieroglyphics.
Sarcophagus	A large stone box that held a mummy's coffin.
