Next Steps / Things to Consider

- Share more curriculum details with parents to support home learning.
- Introduce more play-based learning in Year 1 to ease transition from foundation stage.
- Increase focus on creative subjects like Art and DT (e.g., themed days).
- Expand availability of free clubs for younger children (Foundation and KS1).
- Review fundraising and donation policies for flexibility.
